DAY 1

Discovering **Arezzo**, the city of the film Life is Beautiful by Benigni, where you can admire the magnificent historic center, the Piazza Grande and the Basilica of San Francesco.

In the afternoon, visit *Cortona*, the Etruscan village made famous by the film Under the Tuscan Sun by F. Mayes.

If you like shopping, you can take advantage of the Valdichiana Outlet, where you will find over 140 shops with discounts of up to 70%!



DAY 7

Chianti Classico Tour with a visit to romantic villages, wine castles and wineries in the typical Tuscan hills. You can taste the famous red wine and other typical products, such as extra virgin olive oil and pecorino. Among the places not to be missed are **Radda in Chianti**, **Greve in Chianti**, **Gaiole in Chianti** and **Castellina in Chianti**.

For enthusiasts, it is possible to take this tour with a Vespa, to live an unforgettable experience!



DAY 3

Siena, the city of the Palio and with its Piazza del Campo, where you can admire the splendid gothic cathedral, the Opera del Duomo museum and the Palazzo Pubblico.

Do not forget to taste the typical desserts, such as panforte and ricciarelli!



DAY 4

The best of *Firenze* (possibly by train). Florence is an open-air museum and all major attractions are within walking distance. You can visit the Duomo, the Baptistery, Giotto's Bell Tower, the Uffizi Gallery, the Ponte Vecchio, Palazzo Pitti and the Boboli Gardens.

If you have time, you can go up to Piazzale Michelangelo to enjoy a panoramic view of the city!



DAY 5

San Gimignano, a medieval village (Unesco) with 14 towers and **Volterra** a town founded by the Etruscans on a hill overlooking the hills of the area. You can discover the history and art of these enchanting places, as well as taste local specialties, such as saffron and admire objects made with alabaster.



DAY 6

Choices: *Pienza*, *Montalcino* and *Montepulciano* for lovers of classy wine and tasty cheeses; *Pienza* is the ideal city of the Renaissance wanted by Pope Pius II, Montalcino is famous for Brunello di Montalcino, one of the finest wines in the world, and *Montepulciano* is known for the Vino Nobile di Montepulciano and its underground cellars.

Pisa and **Lucca** are two cities rich in history and monuments, such as the Leaning Tower of Pisa and the Renaissance walls of Lucca, or **Pisa** and **Lucca**, are the furthest from Amoliv but also worth a visit!
